EXPERIENCED LOCAL COUNCILLORS SELECTED FOR NEW UNITARY COUNCIL

The three current councillors for Terriers and Amersham Hill ward have been selected by the local Conservative Party to fight the election for the new Buckinghamshire Council which will take place next May.

Between them they have over 36 years experience of representing the residents of this area. Tony Green was first elected in 1999 and in his 20 years on Wycombe District Council has served in a number of cabinet roles including deputy leader, has been chairman of the High Wycombe Town Committee and has been both Mayor of High Wycombe and Chairman of Wycombe District Council. Arif Hussain has been a District Councillor since 2007, has been deputy leader of the Council and has served in the Council's cabinet. He has been the County Councillor since 2017. Sarfaraz Khan Raja was elected to the District Council in 2015 and has served as Mayor of High Wycombe. He is currently Vice Chairman of the Council.

The new Council will be responsible for all the functions of the current District and County Councils and all three of the councillors are keen to use their experience to ensure that it keeps the best practices of the existing councils while providing a one-stop-shop for residents in all their dealings with the council. Wycombe District Council has always been a well run, efficient Council and they will work hard to ensure that the new Buckinghamshire Council adopts similar good practices.

Elections to the new Council will take place on the 7th May.

STEVE BAKER RE-ELECTED M.P. FOR WYCOMBE

■ At the General Election in December, the conservative candidate Steve Baker was re-elected. The election also returned Boris Johnson as Prime Minister with a parliamentary majority of 79 seats.

In the Queen's speech when Parliament re-opened after the election, the Prime Minister vowed to:

- Seek a future relationship with the European Union based on a free trade agreement that benefits the whole of the United Kingdom. Also to begin trade negotiations with other leading global economies.
 - Embark on an ambitious programme of domestic reform that delivers on the peoples' priorities. For the first time, the National Health Service's multi-year funding settlement, agreed earlier this year, will be enshrined in law.
 - Seek cross-party consensus on proposals for long term reform of social care, ensuring that the social care system provides everyone with the dignity and security they deserve and that no one who needs care has to sell their home to pay for it. Continue work to reform the Mental Health Act..
 - Introduce a modern, fair, points-based immigration system which will welcome skilled workers from across the world to contribute to the United Kingdom's economy, communities and public services.
- Bring forward measures to support working families, raising the National Insurance threshold and increasing the National Living Wage. Ensure every child has access to a high-quality education by increasing levels of funding per pupil in every school.
 - Continue to take steps to meet the world-leading target of net zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2050 and continue to lead the way in tackling global climate change, hosting the COP26 Summit in 2020.
 - Will continue to invest in our gallant Armed Forces. My Government will honour the Armed Forces Covenant, which will be further incorporated into law, and the NATO commitment to spend at least two per cent of national income on defence.
